The Organisation

Córas lompair Éireann (CIÉ) is Ireland's largest public transport operator.

The CIÉ Holding Company is the parent organisation for Iarnród Éireann (Irish Rail), Bus Éireann, and Bus Átha Cliath (Dublin Bus). The CIÉ Group also includes CIÉ Tours International and Rosslare Europort. Collectively, these operations facilitate over 320 million passenger journeys annually, enabling vital national and regional connectivity.

ClÉ provides shared governance, long-term asset stewardship, and enabling support services to its subsidiaries. Working closely with the National Transport Authority and the Department of Transport, ClÉ helps deliver public mobility priorities, supporting Ireland's climate, housing, and transport goals. Strategic co-ordination is provided by ClÉ Group, while each subsidiary operates with a high degree of autonomy. The Holding Company also delivers professional shared services across the Group, including pensions and treasury, and manages its own commercial activities and extensive property portfolio.

The Role

CIÉ is seeking to appoint a Chief Executive Officer to join the CIÉ Group. Reporting directly to the Group Chairperson and to the CIÉ Board, the CEO is responsible for the coordination of the overall strategic vision of the CIÉ Group of companies working collaboratively with the Boards and CEOs of the three subsidiary companies. The CEO leads the Holding Company's client services, including sustainable pension provision, to the CIÉ Group of companies, and provides direct oversight of CIÉ Tours. This is a senior position and represents a unique opportunity to make use of initiative and creativity, but particularly the ability to help shape the delivery of public transport services into the future.

The Person

The ideal candidate will have had a substantial career to date and will have operated at the top level of a professional services organisation or similar. They will be an exceptional leader who has demonstrable experience leading large, complex organisations, ideally in infrastructure, transport, capital projects or public services. As important as previous experience will be the demonstration of senior management impact, stakeholder management, and the ability to take initiatives which determine and manage change.
